Ogof Llechwyn



Ty'n y Ddôl

Tŷ hynod ei arddull yn dyddio o 1905.

Hendre Gwenllian

Nid oes sicrwydd ond credir mai Gwenllian (1097-1136) merch Gruffydd ap Cynan yd'i'r Gwenllian hon. Roedd Gruffydd yn frenin Gwynedd (1055-1137).



Garreg Fawr

A house dating back to the 16th century once owned by the Wynn's of Gwydir.

Ogof Llechwyn

The house was once a tollgate when this was the main road. Nearby there are hut circle remains and tradition tells of treason and betrayal here.

Ty'n y Ddôl

Unique in style the house dates back to 1905.

Hendre Gwenllian

It is uncertain who this Gwenllian is – possibly Gwenllian (1097-1136) the daughter of Gruffydd ap Cynan king of Gwynedd (1055-1137).

Tyddyn Gwyn

Bu pedair cenhedlaeth o deulu'r Mordecai yn gwehyddu yma yn 17eg ganrif.

Moel Dinas

Hen fryngaer yn codi 500-600 troedfedd uwchben y môr yn agos at Fferm Dinas.

Y Wern

Ffermdy hynafol yn dyddio o'r 16eg ganrif fu'n gartref i'r Parch. Richard Jones (1771-1833) emynydd a diwinydd ac i Thomas Richards (1883-1958) bardd a phorthmon.

Tyddyn Gwyn

Four generations of the Mordecai family, who were 17th century weavers, lived here.

Moel Dinas

Above Dinas farm a hill fort that rises 500-600 feet above sea level.

Y Wern

An old farmhouse dating back to 16th century, once the home of Rev. Richard Jones (1771-1833) hymn writer and theologian, and Thomas Richards (1883-1958) poet and drover.

1 O Garreg cerdded ar yr A4085 am Feddgelert. Troi i'r Dde (Dd.) mewn 400medr am Groesor.


2 Ar ôl trac i Traian troi i'r Dd. fyny stepiau a chamfa i giât yn arwain at lethr agored. Dilyn llwybr i fyny'r llethr at giât haearn sy'n arwain at drac. Troi i'r Chwith (Ch.) trwy giât o flaen Garreg Fawr. Heibio'r tŷ at giât yn arwain i goedwig. Cyraedd trac gwelw a dringo fyny am 1 Km at giât wrth gyffordd â ffordd fach.

3 Troi i'r Dd. ar hyd y ffordd, mynd trwy giât allan o'r goedwig ac ymlaen trwy dir agored, trwy giât arall, a disgyn lawr tuag at Dan y Bwlch. Troi i'r Dd. ar lwybr wrth giât a stepiau ychydig cyn tŷ Ogof Llechwyn.

4 Ymlaen at bont droed, a thrwy giât yng nghornel y cae, croesi pont droed arall a cherdded wrth yr Afon Rhyd. Mynd trwy giât mochyn lawr at dŷ Ty'n Ddol.

5 Troi i'r Dd. wrth y tŷ. Mynd dros bont droed, trwy gatiâu ac i fyny wrth ochr ffens. Mynd trwy giât yn y ffens, i'r Dd. fyny'r cae at giât. Cadw i'r Ch. at giât fach yna i'r Dd. I'r Ch. wrth gornel y wal ac ymlaen at giât bren. Cadw i'r Dd. at gamfa dros ffens ac i'r Ch. lawr drwy berthlys. Mae dam gwastad yn arwain at gamfa a thrac. Troi i'r Dd. at giât wrth Hendre Gwenllian. Cadw i'r Dd., fyny'r llethr at giât mochyn. Dilyn ymyl y cae ar y Ch. at giât wrth dŷ Tyddyn Gwyn.

6 Troi i'r Ch. lawr trac at giât a ffordd. Ymlaen lawr y trac at Fferm Dinas. Ynghornel y trac mynd trwy giât, croesi'r cae at ail giât a gwyro i'r Dd. at gamfa gerrig dros wal. Mynd ar i lawr gan gaddw i'r chwith at gamfa gerig. Ymlaen trwy fwlch, cadw i'r Ch. o'r adfail ar goeden



dderw yn y cae nesaf. Ymlaen ac ar draws i ffordd fach.

7 Troi i'r Dd. lawr y ffordd. Mynd trwy giât wrth sgubor. Heibio tŷ'r Wern. Troi i'r Dd. wrth gyffordd mewn 200medr. Ar ôl giât, syth ymlaen ar lwybr sy'n codi'n araf at giât mochyn. Dod lawr heibio dau fwthyn at y A4085 gyferbyn â thafam Brondanw.

Ymwadiad - Aseswyd y llwybr ar y daflen hon yn ystod Haf 2013. Ni fydd Cyngor Cymuned Llanfrothen yn derbyn unrhyw gyfrifoldeb am newidiadau i'r llwybr. Mae rhan fwyaf y teithiau ar lwybrau cyhoeddus, er bod rhai darnau ar lwybrau goddefol. Roedd y wybodaeth yn y daflen hon yn gywir adeg ei argraffu. Ni fydd y Tirfeddiannwyr, Cyngor Cymuned Llanfrothen a'i bartneriad yn derbyn unrhyw gyfrifoldeb am ddamweiniau neu anafiadau ar y teithiau cerdded hyn. Mae cerddwyr yn gyfrifol am eu diogelwch eu hunain. Dylid gwisgo dillad ac esgidiau addas a chadarnhau natur y tywydd cyn mentro allan pob tro.

through gap. Pass to L of ruin and oak tree in next field. Continue across to minor road.

7 Turn R down road. Go through gate by barn. Pass Y Wern house on R. Turn R at junction in 200 metres. After gate, go straight ahead along a path which climbs gradually to kissing gate. Descend past two cottages to reach A4085 opposite Brondanw Arms.

1 From Garreg, walk towards Beddgelert on A4085. Turn R up minor road towards Croesor.

2 After track to Traian, turn R up set of steps and stile to gate leading to open hillside. Follow path upwards across the slope to iron gate which leads to track. Turn L and pass through gate in front of Garreg Fawr: Continue past house up to gate into forestry. Reach better track and continue uphill for a kilometre to gate at junction with minor road.

3 Turn R along road, pass through gate out of forestry and continue over open ground, through another gate, descending towards Tan y Bwlch. Turn R on footpath at gate and steps just before Ogof Llechwyn house.

4 Go ahead to a footbridge, through gate at corner of the field and cross another footbridge to walk by Afon Rhyd. Pass through kissing gate and walk down to Ty'n Ddol house.

5 Turn R by house. Go over footbridge, through gates and uphill alongside fence. Go through gate in fence then R up field to gate. Bear L to small gate, then R. Take L fork by wall corner then go ahead to wooden gate. Bear R to stile over fence and go L down through copse. A flat section leads to a stile and track. Turn L to gate by Hendre Gwenllian. Contour R then go uphill to kissing gate. Follow field edge L to gate by Tyddyn Gwyn house.

6 Turn L down track to gate and road. Continue ahead down track towards Dinas Farm. On corner of track go through gate, cross field to second gate and bear R down to stone stile over wall. Head downhill, bearing L to stone stile. Go ahead
